INFORMATION BULLETIN NO.2

To : ALL IDBF MEMBERS AND NON-MEMBER DRAGON BOAT ORGANIZATIONS.

The Provisional Entries have been received for the 7th Club Crew World Championships (CCWC) over 200 Club Crews from Australia, Canada, Czech Republic, China, Germany, Great Britain, Hong Kong, Hungary, Malaysia, Macau, New Zealand, Philippines, Russia, Singapore, Trinidad, UAE, Ukraine and USA.

It is estimated that the total number of athletes who will compete in Macau 2010 will be around 4,500. With less than four months to go, now is the time for you to confirm with the Organizing Committee your intention to compete in the CCWC.

Division, Racing & competition Classes and Distances

Venue and Race Course

All racing will take place on the Nam Van Lake Nautical Centre, Macao; to see the course go to www.macau2010ccwc.com

Championships Classes.

The competition Divisions, Racing and competition classes that will be contested are listed below, provided that sufficient entries are received for each competition class.

For the CCWC a minimum of six entries from different IDBF Member Associations or Non-Member Dragon Boat Associations is required per competition class for World Championship status, while at least three entries per competition class are required to qualify for IDBF championship status. Each Country or Territory may enter 5 crews, per Competition class.

For your information, one Club can enter the Standard or Small Boat Races, but the Small Boat paddlers have to all be different paddlers from those in any of the Standard boat crews.

Age Regulations: Seniors A - over 40. Senior B (Grand Dragons) over 50 as of 1 June 2010

Junior A - Under 18 but 12 or over. Junior B- Under 16 but 12 or over as of 1 January 2010

Under 23s - under 23 but 18 or over as of 1 January 2010 (6 crew members may be U18 - Small Boat 3)

Each crew's entry to the 2010 CCWC must be sanctioned by the IDBF member organization to which that crew belongs, where one exists. Crews from countries or territories where there is not an IDBF member may compete, subject to the agreement of the IDBF Executive Committee.

All entries are to be sent to IDBF directly, with all administrative information and returns going to the Macao 2010 Organizing Committee.

Technical & Administrative Information

Competition Regulations and Racing Rules

The Macau 2010 CCWC will comply with the IDBF Competition Regulations and will be conducted under the IDBF Rules of Racing, copies of which will be forwarded to crews who return completed Named Entries. Information Bulletins will be published to confirm crew entries at a later date.





Dragon Boat & Paddles - IDBF Specification dragon boats will be provided for this event. Crews are informed that only IDBF Spec 202a Racing paddles will be permitted in the CCWC.

Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs) - Under the IDBF Competition Regulations participants are not required to wear PFDs when racing, unless the Chief Official so decides in inclement weather. However, approved PFDs will be available from the Organizing Committee for those participants who may wish to use them, by prior notification and application.

Participants Photographs - All participants, that is, competitors, coaches, managers, supporters and any other members for whom a Registration fee is due, will be required to submit two(2) passport size (4cm x 6 cm) photographs with the Named Entry Form.

Photographs are to be submitted either by mail to 747 Avenida Amizade R/C Loja " F " Edf. Chong Yu, Macau or by e-mail to macau2010ccwc@gmail.com .

Photographs submitted by mail must measure (4cm x 6cm) and have the name of the person concerned, and their Club Crew Team is to be clearly written on the back of each photograph.

Photographs submitted by e-mail must not be more than 200KB. Each email picture must clearly identify the person concerned with the individual's name and crew below the picture image.

Crew/Team History - Each Club Crew is asked to provide a brief description (100 - 150 words) of the crew, for inclusion in the Championship's Programme.

Crew Training - Crew training sessions will be available at the race venue from:

Sunday 25 July 2010 to Wednesday 28 July 2010

unless, 28 July is shown as a racing day in the published Race Programme. (28 July is presently a " reserve " racing day.) Once a confirmed Entry has been made, crews can book training sessions by using the Crew Training Booking Form attached to this Information Bulletin.





Administration & Logistics

Regatta Fees

An IDBF Registration fee of USD 10.00 per person, is to be paid by all participants in the CCWC.

For this CCWC no Administrative Fee will be charged by the Organizing Committee.

Shuttle Services

The Organizing Committee has made available bus transportation from Macau International Airport, Macau Terminal, Macau - China Border-Gate to official event hotels and return to the Airport, Terminal and Border-Gate at the conclusion of the event. In order to take advantage of this service, it will be necessary for all (or a majority) of crew members and their guests to arrive and depart at the same time and stay at one of the official event hotels. This service is not available where crew members are arriving or departing at significantly different times on the same day or on different days.

The Organizing Committee also has made available shuttle bus transportation for crews and their registered guests to and from official event hotels and the race site each practice day and race day, and to and from the Celebration Dinner Party. These transportation charges will not be included in the accommodation package.

Race Day Lunches

Lunches will be available to all competitors and their coaches, managers and registered supporters on the competition days; the cost will not be included in the accommodation package.





Celebration Dinner Party

A complementary celebration dinner party will be provided following the completion of the Championships for all competitors and their coaches, managers and registered supporters, but the total number of participants, per Club, must be given to the Macau 2010 Organizing Committee by 3rd May, 2010 with a Club's Confirmed Numerative Entry.

Wednesday, 28 July 2010 will be the reserve racing day in the event that the number of crews racing necessitates an extra day's racing.

Competing crews are advised to arrive in Macao no later than Tuesday 27 July 2010, but crews arriving earlier will be catered for.
